

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION (*Diploma in Handloom & Textile Technology*)

- a) Advertisement in the leading local newspapers and other media inviting applications from the intending candidates for admission into First Year/Semester of Six Semesters DHTT Course are being published every year in the month of May/June through the respective State Directorate of Handloom & Textiles.
- b) Merit list of all the eligible candidates prepared by the Selection Committee.
- c) After receiving the merit list, the Director (Institute) issues the letter to the eligible candidates for counseling as per their order of merit.
- d) At the time of reporting for counseling before the Counseling Committee, the candidates are required to produce all certificates in original, medical fitness certificate and one set photocopy of each documents and four copies of their photograph identical to the one pasted on the application form. If the original certificates are in regional language, duly certified English version/translation of such certificates are to be produced for verification.
- e) A candidate who is allotted the seat for admission is required to pay admission fee in cash/Demand Draft on the spot at the time of counseling/admission.
- f) A candidate who fails to appear in person on the notified date and time for counseling, forfeits his/her claim for the seat offered to him/ her and such seat is offered to the next candidate in the merit list.
- g) Vacancy of seats arises if any due to cancellation or any other reasons is notified for second counseling and invite the candidate(s) from the merit list.
- h) An affidavit pertaining to stipend in the prescribed format on the non- judicial stamp paper of RS.100/- duly attested by Notary would be required to submit by the candidates at the time of admission.

INSTITUTIONAL INFORMATION

a) **INTAKE CAPACITY:**

In Karnataka Handloom Technology Institute, Gadag, Karnataka for 40 students of intake is approved.

b) **COURSE:**

Diploma in Handloom & Textile Technology.

c) **DURATION OF THE COURSE:**

3 years duration (First year in non-semester pattern)

d) **AFFILIATING BODY AND TYPE OF MANAGEMENT :**

Government of India, Ministry of Textiles, 010, Development Commissioner for Handlooms, Udyog Bhavan, New Delhi-110011.

e) **QUALIFICATION FOR ADMISSION:**

The candidates should have passed 10th Standard or equivalent with English as a subject of study in the eligible qualification.

f) **AGE LIMIT (AS ON 16th JULY):**

The candidates should be between 15 to 23 years and for SC/ST candidates age should be between 15 to 25 years.

g) **RESERVATIONS:**

i] As per the Karnataka State Government reservation policies for SC/ST/OBC, etc.

ii] In addition, 20% of the total seats allocated to a State are reserved for candidates belonging to Weavers' Profession. Shortfall will be met out from the candidates other than Weavers' Profession.

h) STIPEND :

- i] Stipend will be paid per month @ Rs. 1000/-, Rs. 1100/- & RS.1200/- first year, second year and third year respectively on the basis of 50:50 Karnataka and respective state share during the course of study in the Institute (other state students).
- ii] The students will be eligible for grant of stipend for the whole semester/year, except vacation periods.
- iii] The students will be eligible for stipend only when he/she has put in 80% of class attendance. In case a student has not recorded 80% class attendance in a particular month, he/she has to forgo the stipend for that particular month.
- iv] The students should execute an affidavit in the prescribed form, at the time of admission in the Institute.

i) HOSTEL & ACCOMMODATION:

Well-equipped hostel for boys is available in the institute campus. Students requiring hostel accommodation should request through prescribed application format to the Principal well in advance. In the selection for admission to the hostel, aspects such as distance from native place, economic condition of the parents, student's health, behavior in the past and merit etc., will also be considered.

Rs. 165/- (One Hundred Sixty Five Rupees Only) per month is given as room rent to the girls from out station as there is no hostel facility for them.

j) UNIFORM/DRESSES:

As the students will have to work on power looms as well as with other mechanical gadgets in the workshop, it is necessary to wear fitted uniform, as prescribed by the Institute. Students coming in casual loose dresses like dhoti, lungi, sandal etc. will not be admitted to the classes.

k) MEDICAL FACILITIES:

Qualified Doctors on part time basis have been provided to look after the general health of the students throughout the sessions. The doctor's visit the institute at least twice a week and on urgent calls and checkup the health of the students. Each student at the time of admission is expected to undergo a thorough medical checkup by a doctor.

l) GAMES & SPORTS:

The Institute provides amenities for outdoor and indoor games. Every student is expected to take part at least in one of the outdoor games.

m) EDUCATIONAL TOUR AND PROJECT WORK:

As per the curriculum, during winter break from 6th December to 25th December, the students after 3rd semester are required to undertake an Educational Tour to visit important handloom centres, textile mills and other places of general interest to handloom industry to know how the working of different machines and equipment's. And the students after 5th semester are required to undertake a Project Work in different Handloom Cluster Societies and handloom centres in the country to enrich their practical knowledge in the subject topic allotted to them in consultation with guides/sponsors/state authorities.

A grant of Rs.500/- is given to each student for Educational Tour and Project Work, in addition to reimbursement of actual fare by shortest route (sleeper class by train/bus) paid for the travel.
